

Court of Inquiry members meet Legal Advisory Team

Members of the Court of Inquiry, established to conduct an enquiry into the terrorist attacks and subsequent incidents in Buthidaung and Maungtaw areas in Rakhine State, have already visited Buthidaung area for the first time. During the visit, they investigated three military units including a command headquarter, three police stations, a prison and five villages.

In order to receive necessary legal advice on their accomplishments and future investigation in connection with their mission, the members of the Court of Inquiry met with the members of the Legal Advisory Team at the Judge Advocate General Office on 9 July 2019.
