Temporary Measures to Prevent Importation of COVID-19 to Myanmar through Air Travel

29 March 2020

- 1. The coronavirus disease COVID-19 is being imported to Myanmar through air travel and up to 28 March 2020, a total of (8) cases has been confirmed. Therefore, in order to prevent the further importation and subsequent spread of COVID-19 in Myanmar, the Ministry of Health and Sports, with the approval of the National Central Committee for Prevention, Control and Treatment of COVID-19, is putting in place the following temporary measures which will be effective from 30 March 2020 2359 Hours Myanmar Standard Time (MST) up to 13 April 2020 2359 Hours MST:
 - (a) Landing at any airport in Myanmar will not be allowed for all international commercial passenger flights;
 - (b) All landing permissions previously granted by the Department of Civil Aviation are suspended.
- 2. The above temporary measures will not apply to relief flights, all-cargo flights, medical evacuation flights and special flights specifically approved by the Department of Civil Aviation. However, if any such flight involves night stop(s), the flight crew and cabin crew (if applicable) of the said flight may be subject to quarantine requirements of the Ministry of Health and Sports.
